**Sub:** Affiliated Self-financing Colleges of Education shall get Representatives from the University for Selection Procedure for appointment of teaching faculty for the post of Principal, Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professors as per the norms of TNTEU and NCTE - Reg.

**Ref:** Resolution of the Syndicate meeting held on 01.08.2022, Item No.19.

The Managements of the Self-financing Colleges of Education affiliated to this University are informed that the Syndicate at its meeting held on 01.08.2022 considered for including the University Teachers in the Selection Procedure for appointment of teaching faculties by the affiliated self-financing Colleges of Education and resolved as follows:

“ Resolved that the selection procedure is not followed by the self-financing colleges of education for appointment of teaching faculties at their colleges of education as per the Statutes in Appendix-E and the Regulations of NCTE, be noted and action be initiated for including the University Teachers in the Selection Procedure by the affiliated colleges of education for appointment of teaching faculties”.

In view of the above resolution of the Syndicate, it is to be stated that the managements of all the affiliated self-financing Colleges of Education shall get Representatives from the University for selection procedure for appointment of teaching faculties for the post of Principal, Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor as per the norms of Tamil Nadu Teachers Educations University Statutes in Appendix-E and the Regulations of NCTE as follows:

**Assistant Professor in Colleges including Private Colleges:**

- (a) The Selection Committee for the post of Assistant Professor in colleges including Private Colleges shall have the following composition and inter-alia as follows:
4. Two nominees of the Vice-Chancellor of the affiliating University of whom one should be a subject expert.
  5. Two subject-experts not connected with the colleges to be nominated by the Chairperson of the governing body of the college out of a panel of five names recommended by the relevant statutory body of the University concerned.

**Associate Professor in College including Private Colleges:**

- (a) The Selection Committee for the post of Associate Professor in colleges including Private Colleges shall have the following composition and inter-alia as follows:

4. Two University representatives nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, one of whom will be the Dean of College Development council or equivalent position in the University and the other must be expert in the concerned subject.

5. Two subject-experts not connected with the colleges to be nominated by the Chairperson of the governing body of the college out of a panel of five names recommended by the Vice-Chancellor from the list of subject experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the University concerned.

#### College Principal

(a) The Selection Committee for the post of College Principal shall have the following composition and inter-alia as follows:

3. One nominee of the Vice-Chancellor who shall be a Higher Education expert.

4. Three experts consisting of the Principal of a College, a Professor and an accomplished educationist not below the rank of a Professor (to be nominated by the Governing Body of the College) out of a panel of six experts approved by the relevant statutory body of the University concerned.

In whole of the Constitution of Selection Committee for the post of Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Professor and College Principal shall have the following composition as below:

“An academician representing SC/ST/OBC/minority/Women/Differently-abled categories, if any of candidates representing these categories is the applicant, to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor, if any of the above members of the selection committee do not belong to that category”.

Further, the NCTE Regulations 2014 under the caption of Management Committee has stated as follows:

The institution shall have a Managing Committee constituted as per the rules, if any of the affiliating University/concerned State Government. In the absence of such rules, the institution shall constitute the Managing Committee on its own. The Committee shall comprise representatives of the sponsoring society/trust, Educationists and Teacher Educators, representatives of the affiliating university and of the staff.

In the letter No. NCTE-Reg/015/708/2022-Regulation Section-SRC 133101, dated 29.07.2022 from the Under Secretary, NCTE, New Delhi has requested to take necessary action to amend rules and ensure that the faculty selection takes place objectively fulfilling the rules of reservations, social justice etc., at the earliest.

Therefore, the Management of all the affiliated Self-financing Colleges of Education is instructed to follow the above resolution and the norms of TNTEU/NCTE for the selection procedure for appointment of new teaching faculty by the Colleges of Education.
