STUDENTS' CORNER

Five Famous Authors Born in the Month of July

1) Hilaire Belloc (27 July 1870 – 16 July 1953)

Franco-English writer and historian of the early 20th century. Belloc was also an orator, poet, sailor, satirist, writer of letters, soldier, and political activist. His Catholic faith had a strong effect on his works. Belloc's writings encompassed religious poetry and comic verse for children. His widely sold **Cautionary Tales for Children** included "Jim, who ran away from his nurse, and was eaten by a lion" and "Matilda, who told lies and was burned to death". He wrote historical biographies and numerous travel works, including *The Path to Rome* (1902).

Three of his best-known works are:

- ❖ The Servile State (1912)
- **&** *Europe and Faith (1920)*
- ***** *The Jews (1922)*

2) Ernest Miller Hemingway (July 21, 1899 – July 2, 1961)

American novelist, short-story writer, and journalist. His economical and understated style which he termed 'The Iceberg Theory' had a strong influence on 20th-century fiction, while his adventurous lifestyle and public image brought him admiration from later generations. Hemingway produced most of his work between the mid-1920s and the mid-1950s, and he was awarded the 1954 Nobel Prize in Literature. He published seven novels, six short-story collections, and two nonfiction works. Three of his novels, four short-story collections, and three nonfiction works were published posthumously.

Three of his best-known works are:

- ❖ The Sun Also Rises (1926)
- ❖ A Farewell to Arms (1929)
- ❖ The Old Man and the Sea (1953)

3) Nelson Rolihlahla Mandela (18 July 1918 – 5 December 2013)

South African anti-apartheid activist, who served as the first president of South Africa from 1994 to 1999. His negotiations in the early 1990s with F.W. de Klerk helped to end the country's apartheid system of racial segregation and ushered in a peaceful transition to majority rule. Mandela and de Klerk were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize for Peace in 1993 for their efforts. He was the country's first black head of state and the first elected in a fully representative democratic election. His government focused on dismantling the legacy of apartheid by fostering racial reconciliation. Ideologically an African nationalist and socialist, he served as the president of the African National Congress (ANC) party from 1991 to 1997.

Three of his best-known works are:

- ❖ I Am Prepared to Die (1964)
- ❖ No Easy Walk to Freedom (1965)
- ❖ The Struggle Is My Life (1978)

4) Henry David Thoreau (July 12, 1817 – May 6, 1862)

American naturalist, essayist, poet, and philosopher. As a leading transcendentalist, he is best known for his book *Walden*, a reflection upon simple living in natural surroundings, and his essay "Civil Disobedience" (originally published as "Resistance to Civil Government"), an

argument for disobedience to an unjust state. Thoreau's books, articles, essays, journals, and poetry amount to more than 20 volumes. Among his lasting contributions are his writings on natural history and philosophy, in which he anticipated the methods and findings of ecology and environmental history, two sources of modern-day environmentalism.

Three of his best-known works are:

- ❖ Civil Disobedience (1849)
- **❖** *Walking* (1851)
- ***** *Walden (1854)*

5) Joanne (Kathleen) Rowling (born July 31, 1965 - present)

Joanne Rowling with pen name J.K. Rowling born in Yate, near Bristol, England. She is an original British author, creator of the popular and critically acclaimed **Harry** Potter series, about a young sorcerer in training. The book became popular right away, appealing to both adults and children, who were its intended readership. It followed the exploits of the unusual hero Harry Potter, a lonely orphan who learns that he is truly a wizard and enrolls at the School of Witchcraft Hogwarts Wizardry. Because of her famous writings, Rowling was appointed Officer of the Order of the British Empire (OBE) in 2001. In 2009 she was named a chevalier of the French Legion of Honour.

Three of her best-known works are:

- Harry Potter Series (7 books published between 1997-2007)
- ❖ The Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them (2001)
- The Christmas Pig (2021)

EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAY

On 15th July 2022, the 119th birth anniversary of former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu **Thiru. Kumarasamy Kamaraj**, was observed as **Tamil Nadu's Educational Development Day** to remember his contribution to enhance the school education facilities of Tamil Nadu.

Background:

In **2006** the Government of Tamil Nadu passed a development and celebration bill declaring July 15th, the birth day of **PerunthalaivarKamarajar** as the "Educational Development Day".

Biography:

PerunthalaivarKamarajar was born on **15th July 1903** in Virudhunagar, Madurai, Tamil Nadu India. He served as the President of Congress Party for two terms from 1964 to 1967 and since he was well known for the "Kamaraj Plan" for reforming Congress organization in the 1960's. He became the 3rd Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and served 3 consecutive terms from 1954 to 1963. He passed away at the age of 72 on 2nd October 1975 (Gandhi Jayanti Day) due to health issues. He was posthumously awarded with Bharat Ratna, the highest civilian award of India in 1976.

Reforms and Schemes:

'Karmaverar' Kamarajarwho is revered as the **father of the renaissance of Education in Tamil Nadu** has pioneered **900 new elementary schools** and introduced the **mid-day meals scheme** in schools in Tamil Nadu when he was the Chief Minister

during 1954-1963 to provide one meal to poor students. He also introduced the **free school uniform** to remove the cast and creed difference in schools. He made major

industrial reforms in the state like bringing in **Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited** (**BHEL**) in Trichy, **Hindustan Photo Films** in Udhagamandalam (Ooty).

IMMUNOGLOBULIN

Immunoglobulins are special types of glycoproteins that play an important role in maintaining the body's immune system. Also called antibodies, immunoglobulins are highly specific, and they are secreted in massive amounts by plasma cells in response to pathogenic antigens.

Immunoglobulins protect us against:

- > Bacteria
- Chemical substances
- Viruses
- > Parasites
- > Allergens
- > Synthetic substances
- > Cancerous cells

> Fungus

Body fluids that contain

immunoglobulins:

- Breast milk
- Tears
- ❖ Saliva
- **❖** Gastric secretions
- Mucosal secretions

The human body only makes five types of immunoglobulins:

- ✓ IgG
- ✓ IgM
- ✓ IgA
- ✓ IgD
- ✓ IgE

Diseases Related to Deficiency of Immunoglobulins

Immunologists believe that a person could have an immunoglobulin deficiency or non-functional immunoglobulins due to a defective immune system. This is a rare genetic condition known as primary immunodeficiency disease (PIDD). There are more than 300 types of primary immunodeficiency diseases that havealready been reported by medical researchers.

On the other hand, some secondary immunodeficiency disorders are caused by external environmental factors such as:

- **4** Severe malnutrition
- **HIV**
- **♣** Chemotherapeutic agents

A person suffering from primary immunodeficiency diseases is likely to have a weaker immune system and is more prone to infections and other severe immunological problems.
